



All camps, accoutrements, clothing and trade goods are required to be representative of those prior to the 1840 Fur Trade Era.

Loading and unloading is limited to 2 hours on June 18th and 19th. Loading and unloading in Short Term Camp as well as vehicle removal must be done with Short Term gate hours June 20th - 24th.

Rendezvous participants must wear primitive clothing to enter, occupy and leave camp from Opening Ceremonies to after Closing Ceremonies. This includes proper footwear for participants of all ages.

Trade Tokens will be awarded for Rendezvous Events. All 2022 HPRR tokens will need to be redeemed at the 2022 Rendezvous.
