Trade Rules Introduction

While we recognize that the High Plains Regional Rendezvous (HPRR) is not a juried event where participants are held to standards found at living history or interpretive centers, the Association has set its own reasonable rules and regulations to maintain the "spirit" of the North American Fur Trade era. It has been, and will continue to be, held to a higher standard than smaller, localized pre-1840 events and festivals. All participants must be fully aware that they are to abide by the Association's rules for this event when they participate. While the Association recognizes the necessity for flexibility to involve families and grow participation, the HPRR is a **Regional** event. As such, the event is expected to maintain a reasonable representation of the pre-1840 Fur Trade Era, as best as current laws will allow.

Please note that items which may be acceptable at smaller events may be unacceptable at the High Plains. It is the responsibility of each participant, in an attempt to maintain the true "spirit" of the time period, to use and utilize period-correct original or reproduction items (while keeping non-correct items hidden or unpacked) as defined by the Association's Trade Rules and Unacceptable Trade Goods. Registering to attend the annual HPRR constitutes acceptance of the rules and regulations as set forth by the Association, posted on the Original High Plains Regional Rendezvous Association website (www.hpr.org), and on campsite message boards.
